ALL NON-NATIONAL EVENTS START PROMPTLY AT NOON. Mandatory Riders Meeting at 11:45 am

An Observed Trial is a motorcycle competition held on private land in the woods, and is based on skill rather than speed. The object is to ride in balance and control through marked sections consisting of tight turns, hill climbs, rocks and logs. Each time a rider uses his feet to regain his balance, or stops with his foot down, penalty points are assessed by an observer. Therefore, low score wins. The trial consists of a number of sections connected by a short loop. Riders are classified by ability (Rookie, Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, Expert).

All Events are AMA Sanctioned and AMA membership is required and is available at the event. Minors (under 18) must provide a legal release signed by both parents. Competition entry fee is \$15.00

New Riders are always WELCOME. An optional New Rider Orientation will be available at all local events at 10:00 am., “Free of Charge “ for any rider, adult or child, wishing to be introduced to the sport of observed trials. This orientation will be supervised by an experienced rider. Please contact Mark Buczowski for more information (607) 796-0560

Spectator admission for all non-national events is free; If you are a spectator, stand clear of the section. Do not distract the rider from his attempt, and remember that these events are held on private land. Please extend to the landowner the same consideration that you would expect.
